Water, perimeter fencing, initial tilling and plenty of sunshine are provided. The Fluvanna County Community Garden was developed jointly by the Virginia Cooperative Extension, Fluvanna Master Gardeners and FCPR. A community centered gardening atmosphere is available for all interested residents. The garden promotes productive gardening practices and conserving resources to enhance the surrounding environment. The garden is conveniently located at Pleasant Grove. This year an additional 15 plots (10x15ft) are available. Workshops will be provided at not extra charge by Fluvanna Master Gardeners and VCE. Plot Assignments are based on a First Come First Served basis.

Fee: \$45.00 per 10 x 15 plot Early-bird fee by February 15, 2009. \$50.00 after February 15, 2009. Make check payable to Fluvanna Parks and Recreation. Registration closes March 1, 2009.
