Whether you are a newcomer to Central Virginia or an experienced gardener, the Master Gardeners have valuable information to share with you. You will receive training from some of the foremost experts in **Virginia horticulture**, **landscape design**, **soil challenges**, **deer avoidance**, **plant diseases**, **all about insects** and **water conservation**.

What is the Master Gardener Program?

The Master Gardener Program is a volunteer education partnership with Virginia Cooperative Extension. It is dedicated to working with the community to promote environmentally sound horticulture practices through sustainable landscape management.

Each participant receives 50 hours of classroom and field instruction. After completing this training, a 50-hour internship as a horticulture volunteer is required to achieve certification as a Master Gardener.

As a volunteer, you will help with horticulture programs and activities to enhance the community, protect the environment, and educate others. It is an excellent way to meet new friends, serve your community, help build a greener planet, and meet the challenges of gardening in Central Virginia.
